Isuzu Motors Company (Thailand) Limited (IMCT) was established in 1966 as an overseas plant of Isuzu Motors Limited. With over half a century of operations in Thailand, IMCT has become one of the leading automobile manufacturing companies in the country. Our product range includes pickups and heavy-duty trucks. We are also a key component of the Isuzu Asia community, excelling in Product Planning, Research and Development, Manufacturing, Marketing, and Export. After Isuzu transferred its production base for Light Commercial Vehicles (LCV) to Thailand in 2002, we expanded our functions and became the LCV headquarters upon acquiring the main engineering activities from Isuzu in 2010.

In 2011, IMCT launched the fully redesigned D-MAX, offering top-quality products to meet our customers' needs. Our new LCV plant began operations at Gateway in October 2012, increasing LCV production capacity. We subsequently started operating a Free Zone at the Gateway Plant in October 2014. The Gateway Plant is now IMCT's second production base, capable of producing up to 350,000 units of LCV per year, with improved quality and more efficient cost management. This enhanced production capability has allowed IMCT to successfully expand its business worldwide.

The year 2023 marked a significant milestone in IMCT's history as we achieved the production of 6 million Isuzu vehicles. Today, IMCT is regarded as the LCV production base of the Isuzu Group. We are committed to flourishing as the LCV headquarters and delivering the best products to satisfy customers around the world.

In 2025, IMCT began production of the Isuzu D-MAX EV, our first-ever electric pickup truck, developed for export markets. This achievement is a key step toward realizing Isuzu Group's Environmental Vision 2050, which aims for net-zero greenhouse gas emissions. The D-MAX EV demonstrates our progress in developing alternative energy vehicles to support carbon neutrality by 2030. IMCT will continue working with Isuzu Group companies under the multi-pathways strategy to deliver a full range of high-quality products, from diesel to alternative energy vehicles, adapted to each country's needs, while contributing to a circular economy.

To ensure sustainable growth, IMCT applies ESG-focused management in line with Isuzu Motors Limited's corporate philosophy. We are committed to creating long-term value through environmental stewardship, social responsibility, and sound corporate governance, supporting our mission: "ISUZU - Moving the World for You."

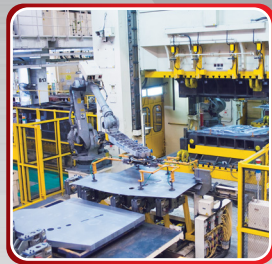

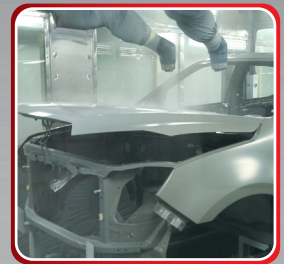

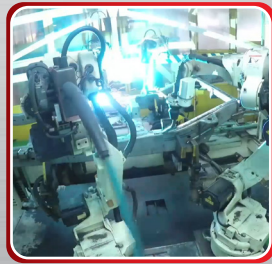

We are capable of manufacturing vehicles efficiently because of consistent work flow from press process to final assembly process with the production capacity of 385,000 units per year of both pickups and 2-ton up truck altogether.

> The leading of highest production technology

We adopt the latest technology including robots and automatic system to increase productivity as well as Ro-Dip (Rotation Dipping) system which allows us to produce high quality anti-rust and beautiful body painting. We do “Surfacer”, “Base Coating” and “Clear Coating” in succession called “3WET” technology. It allows a high quality painting as well as energy saving.

> The leading of good working environment

IMCT works under the slogan “Every employee is the most important person in production”. For example, at the paint factory we put oven on the top floor to prevent hot temperature in factory. We aim at reducing “fatigue”, “stress” and “danger”.

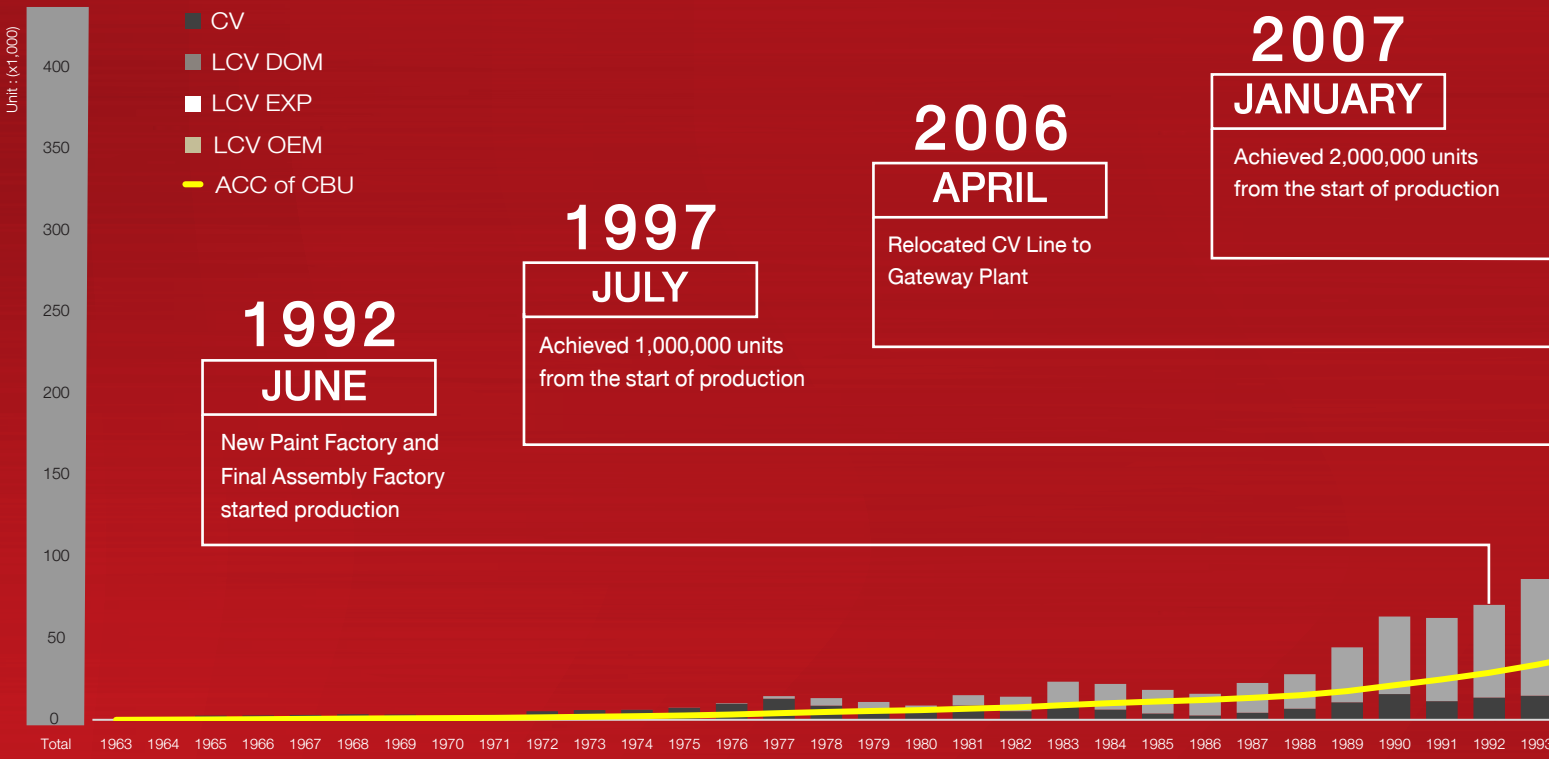
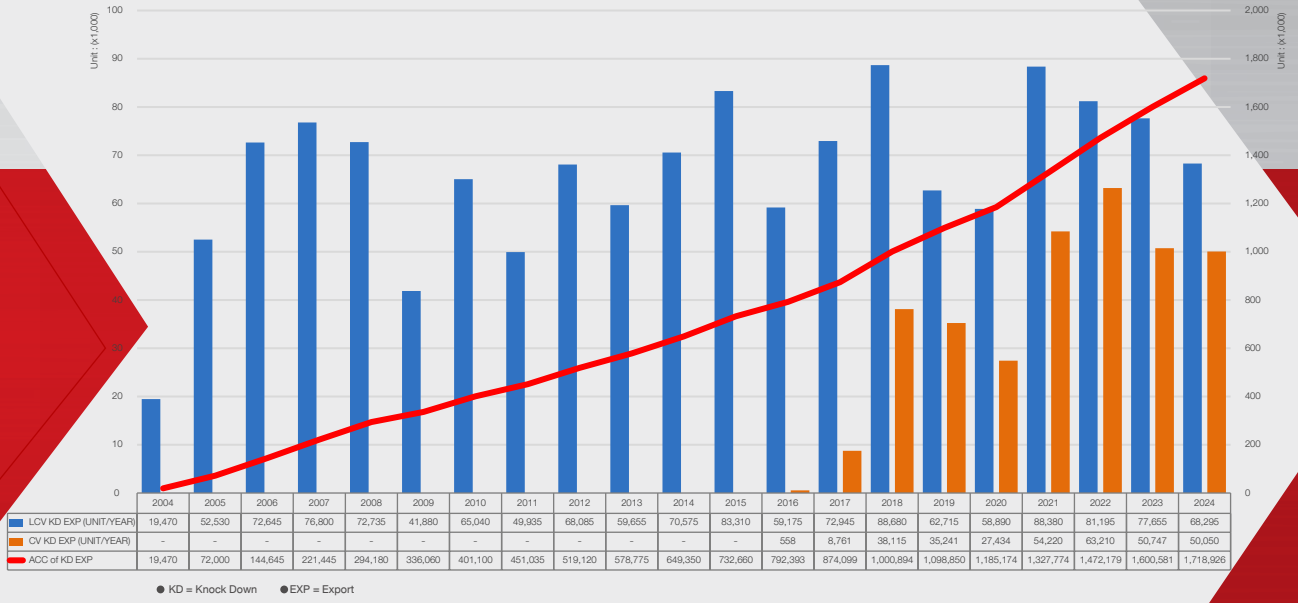

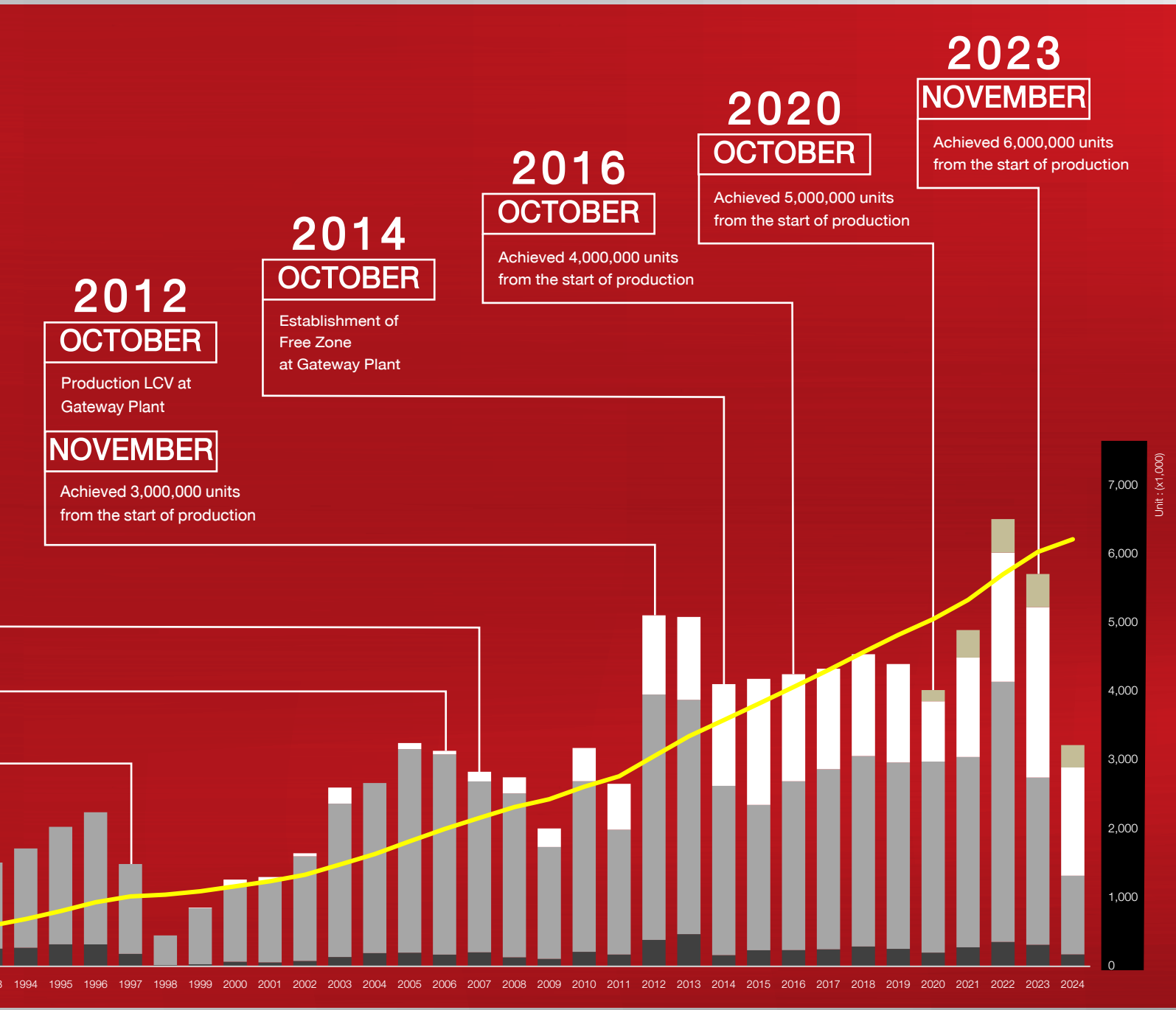
